Tempelhofer Feld is a place of diverse sounds, tones and noises:

The fluttering of a stunt kite here, the chirping of a skylark there and the barking of a dog there. But it is also one of the last quiet inner-city areas in this city. A retreat, a quiet zone and a place to relax and slow down for many Berliners.

We all know and love the field as a place for local recreation, encounters and nature. Tempelhofer Feld is valuable and so much more than the sum of its parts and a unique example of civic creativity. Numerous artistic and civic projects find space to develop here.
