



Great caffeine addiction Café Route East

Introduction

A **slow Saturday route** for coffee lovers starts at noon at the **KulturCafé** in Friedelstraße. In addition to butterflies and collages made from flower petals, guests can relax on cushions in the back room and experience an island of inner silence with the help of headphones. Accompanied by meditations, you have the opportunity to write or draw your impressions in the **Book of Silence**. Inspiring quotes from Eckhart Tolle and Ety Hillesum emphasise the importance of inner peace and mindfulness in the midst of the hustle and bustle of the city. In the project **Voiced Silence. Collage storytelling at Café Square**, the city becomes the central setting for **Vladimir Kordiukov's** collage narratives permeated by silence. These collages not only tell stories, but also turn the city itself into an active participant in the project. Kordiukov uses the collages as a creative process, collecting and arranging visual elements to create new stories or reinterpret existing ones. Each collage resonates with urban life and reminds us that even small objects carry their own story.

We continue to the **Endorphina Café**, which offers an extensive programme in its beautiful backyard. Among other things, you can experience one of this year's highlight projects there on **Saturday at 4 pm: Ear action** is an experimental project that explores the space between hearing and feeling. In a one-to-one performance, guests wear noise-cancelling headphones that serve as resonating bodies and are played with various objects in order to make the physical potential of sounds tangible. The artists **Stellan Veloce and Neo Hülcker** have developed their own practice of intimate ear playback, inspired by the sensory phenomenon "ASMR". The project moves between performance, treatment and composition and is in a continuous process of further development and exploration.

Not so far away is the barrier-free, multimedia and interactive installation **CELL:LAPSE - Connection through Condensation** by **Anna Rezzolla and Anna Scheibner**. It opens to the side and spreads out in a spiral, with a glass-like central artefact made of transparent corrugated plastic with built-in loudspeakers playing sound collages, making the installation reminiscent of an abstract auricle. Muscle fibre-like foam clouds float through it, which can be set in motion by pulling ropes and also contain loudspeakers. Ropes with urban artefacts scattered around the room invite the audience to touch and change the installation, bringing it to life. As soon as the installation remains untouched, it returns to its chaotic original form. CELL:LAPSE illustrates that we can significantly influence the density and composition of our surroundings and brings together the concepts of urbanity and silence in a fascinating way. On **Saturday at 11am** and **1.30pm**, there will also be two **guided tours for kids by Tanja** in the Endorphina courtyard.

If you still haven't had enough art after the programme at Endorphina, you can continue along the route and treat yourself to another coffee in the Richardkiez.

In the art project **Gedruckte.Visionen** in the cosy **Café Alma**, **Susanne Uitz** presents a variety of works that deal with print and illustration media. She uses experimental techniques to show her individual view of printed art. The works often reflect the artist herself and play with the tension between self-portrayal and self-criticism. The personal view of life situations of a young person in Berlin is presented in an imaginative way.

The second project, **What is beneath the surface?** by **Magdalena Feigl and Amanda Ezquerro Sanchez**, reflects on the hectic dynamics of the big city and raises the question of how we can imagine ourselves in a constantly changing environment. It addresses the diversity of interpretations of words, names and concepts and creates space for individual perspectives that enrich society. The exhibition strives to create a place of deceleration and deconstruction that goes beyond preconceived notions to liberate the individual mind. Through the process of rethinking and redesigning, visitors are invited to explore and share their imagination and ideas. You've made it! Now off to the round of 16 of Euro 2024!
