## Stop 1

#### POLYMEDIALER PONYHOF, KIENITZER STR. 11

**18 PROJECTS - 27 ARTISTS**

Discover a very special attraction at this year's festival: the Polymedial Pony Farm! This unique area of the festival brings together the creative energy of 27 artists who will present their visions in a total of 18 fascinating projects.

### **EV. BRÜDERGEMEINE, KIRCHGASSE. 14**

12 PROJECTS - 30 ARTISTS

Your journey continues to the Evangelical Church of the Brethren. This special place is a surprising counterpoint on the 'No Limits Route'. Here, where history and community meet contemporary art, a unique atmosphere awaits you. ## Stop 3

#### PRACHTWERK, GANGHOFERSTR. 2

#### THE ALEPH - A SIGNAL DIRECTLY ON YOUR WAY

This fascinating 7-metre-high signal project by Paula Vidal was specially designed for public spaces and is impossible to miss. With its reflective surface, the walk-in installation is a shining point in the festival area that you should definitely not miss.
