Station 1

POLYMEDIALER PONYHOF, KIENITZER STR. 11 **WHERE THE BODY BECOMES A CANVAS**

Lisa-Maria Damm takes you on a dance journey that takes Donna Haraway's Cyborg Manifesto as its starting point. It is about the female body in the digital age and how the 'male gaze' influences our perception. Look forward to a performance that playfully combines organic and mechanical elements and frees the body from reproductive duties. Lust and freedom are the themes here - and there's also an accompanying photo exhibition!

In 'Naked 2', **Kay Kastner** sheds light on the subject of nudity in a very personal way. What happens when we leave binary thinking behind? **Maria Karamoutsiou** and **Natalie Giannopoulos** explore the deconstruction of the binary in this multimedia dance performance. Whether male/female, art/pedagogy - every dichotomy is questioned here. It is about individual journeys and a collective upheaval, about rethinking structures and recognising diversity. There's also a video installation in the shop window of the Ponyhof - perfect for catching a glimpse from the outside!

ROTBART, BÖHMISCHE STRASSE 43 A LOVE LETTER TO THE HUMAN BODY

Sindoni. An interrupted frequency

PHOTOGRAPHY

Then it's off to Rotbart, where **Elisa Galelli's** "Sindoni. An interrupted frequency" awaits you. This photo project is a love letter to the human body, elevating it to a more abstract, almost divine level. Cyanotype prints of body parts, which are reassembled, create images that challenge our perception. Muscles, scars, marks - here each body tells its own story. It is an invitation to experience the human form beyond the visible and to find a spiritual connection to it.

Next, we head to the Blue Dragon Tattoo Studio, where the 'EXPERIMENTAL FIGURE WORKSHOP' takes place. Here, everything revolves around the question: What is a 'realistic' human body? And how does our perception shape - or distort - the truth? This collective of artists explores the mutable nature of truth in art. Each artist brings their own vision, linked by a common element such as a tool, a colour or a technique. Be challenged to experience art as a fluid, interpretive process that opens up new ways of seeing.

Station 4

RINGBAR, SCHWARZASTRASSE 1 ANATOMY OF THE HOLE AND QUEER DIALOGUES

Anatomy of the Hole: A Queer Dialogue

Our last stop is the Ringbar, where 'Anatomy of the Hole: A Queer Dialogue' awaits you. This exhibition explores the 'hole' as a physical, symbolic and social motif. The works of **András Vizi** and **Leander von Thien** create a dialogue about queer bodies, spaces and their social coding. It is about intimacy and desire, shame and vulnerability, anonymity and visibility. The exhibition scrutinises how bodies, spaces and norms shape our understanding of desire, shame and identity. What do we really see when we look - and what remains hidden from us? Spaces for dialogue, self-reflection and queer liberation are uncovered here.

This route is a tribute to the diversity of the human body and its representation in art. Let yourself be inspired, surprised and perhaps even a little provoked.
