Our first stop is at K-Fetisch, where the documentary 'Creatures of Life' will cast a spell over you. Forget everything you think you know about drag! This is about more than just glitter and lipstick. WHEN EVEN THE WORM FIGHTS BACK!

Even A Worm Will Turn

Just a stone's throw away, in No.1 Main Road, **Lauryn Youden's** 'Even A Worm Will Turn' awaits you. It's profound and a little uncomfortable here - but in the best possible way! The exhibition exposes the hidden violence in medical spaces and modernist architecture. Sounds complicated? But it's not!

It's all about 'Queer Crip Time' - an invitation to embrace the irregular rhythms of chronic illness and disability. Forget straightforward progress! Here, everything is softer, stranger, more alive (and maybe even a little undead). And look out for the ghostly prize ponies - they are glittering symbols that remind us how vulnerable bodies are valued and exploited. It's an outcry calling for a future where survival is not only possible, but shines with defiance. Don't be fooled by the 'cute aesthetics' - there's some badass resistance in here!



Station 3

GÖTTIN DER WEISHEIT, LENAUSTRASSE 5 WHEN COLLAGES FIGHT AGAINST TYRANNY

Manticore - Tyranny and Oppression

Our last stop takes us to the Goddess of Wisdom, where the exhibition 'Mantikor - Tyranny and Oppression' awaits. Here you will be mesmerised by the collages of Mantikor, the man-eater. These works of art vividly show how violence against women affects our emotions.

The centrepiece is a photo of an unknown woman from 1941, taken after the manhunt in Lviv. It is a representative symbol for all women who have experienced violence, humiliation and murder. This exhibition is a reminder, a wake-up call and a deeply moving confrontation with history. It will not leave you cold. By **Carola Aurer**.
